



"Share Link" on T-OnTheGo™ for iOS/Android

Advance notice about using the T-OnTheGo™:

- Before you use a WebDAV connection, first make sure that your ThecusOS is up-to-date. The WebDAV service has been enabled by default on your NAS.

The firmware must be the versions and compatible models below:

- ThecusOS 5 64bit version **2.05.01** and above: N2800, N4800, N4800Eco, N4510U, N5550, N7510, N7700PRO v2, N8800PRO v2, N8900, N8900V, N12000, N12000PRO, N12000V, N16000, N16000PRO, N16000V, TopTower N8850, TopTower N6850, TopTower N10850
- ThecusOS 6.1-12 & OS6.build_340 and above: N2520, N2560, N4520, N4560
- ThecusOS 6.build_767 and above: N2310, N4310

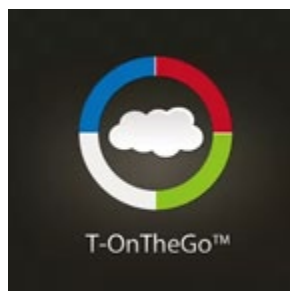

Find **T-OnTheGo™** in the **App Store** or **Google Play**.

Download and install the App from there.

❖ Before using “Share Link”, something you should know

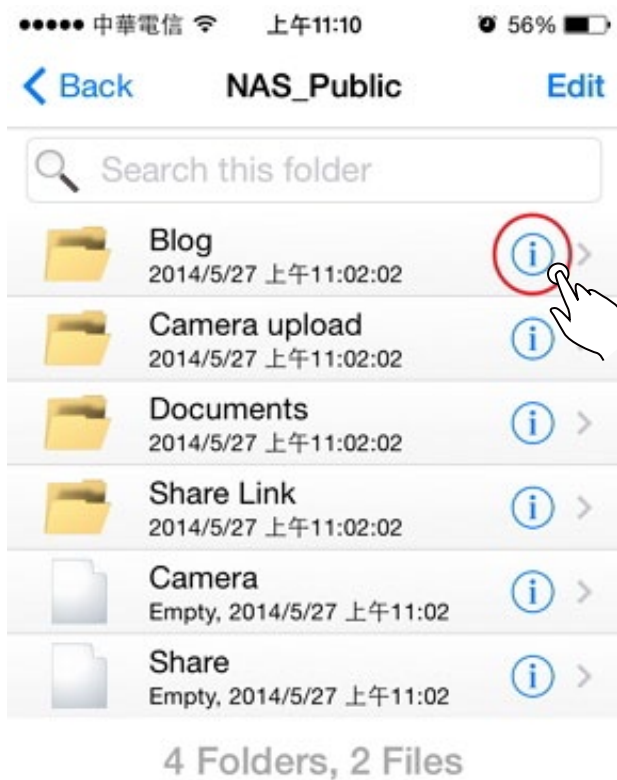
1. We strongly recommend that you should **change the password** for Admin UI first.
2. You **CANNOT** share link via a internal IP (e.g. 192.168.x.x) .
3. The following condition is only on iOS version:
If “Share Link” icon is disappeared, please make sure that you have at least an email account on your iDevice.
4. If you share a file/folder in a “shared folder” with ACL (privilege) , the user who received the link can download files from it **WITHOUT** privilege.

❖ 3-Step to share your files (for iOS)

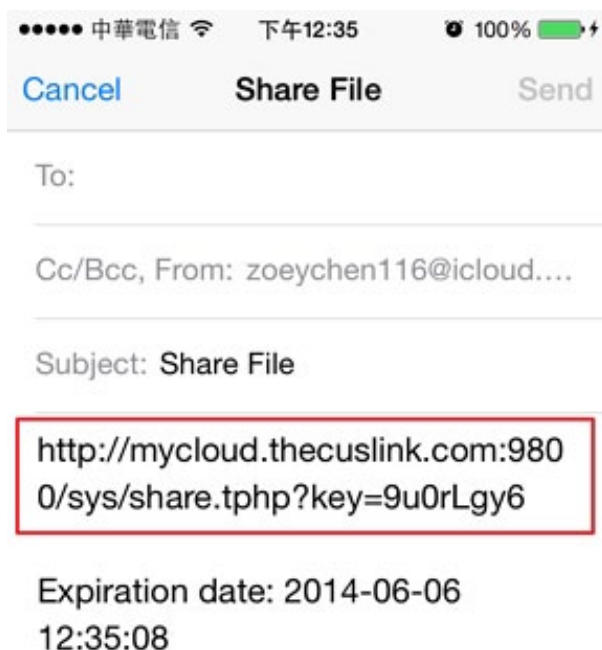
Step 1: Tap the ⓘ icon

Step 2: Tap the 📄 icon

Note: If you never setup an Email account on your iDevice, the 📄 icon will not be displayed.



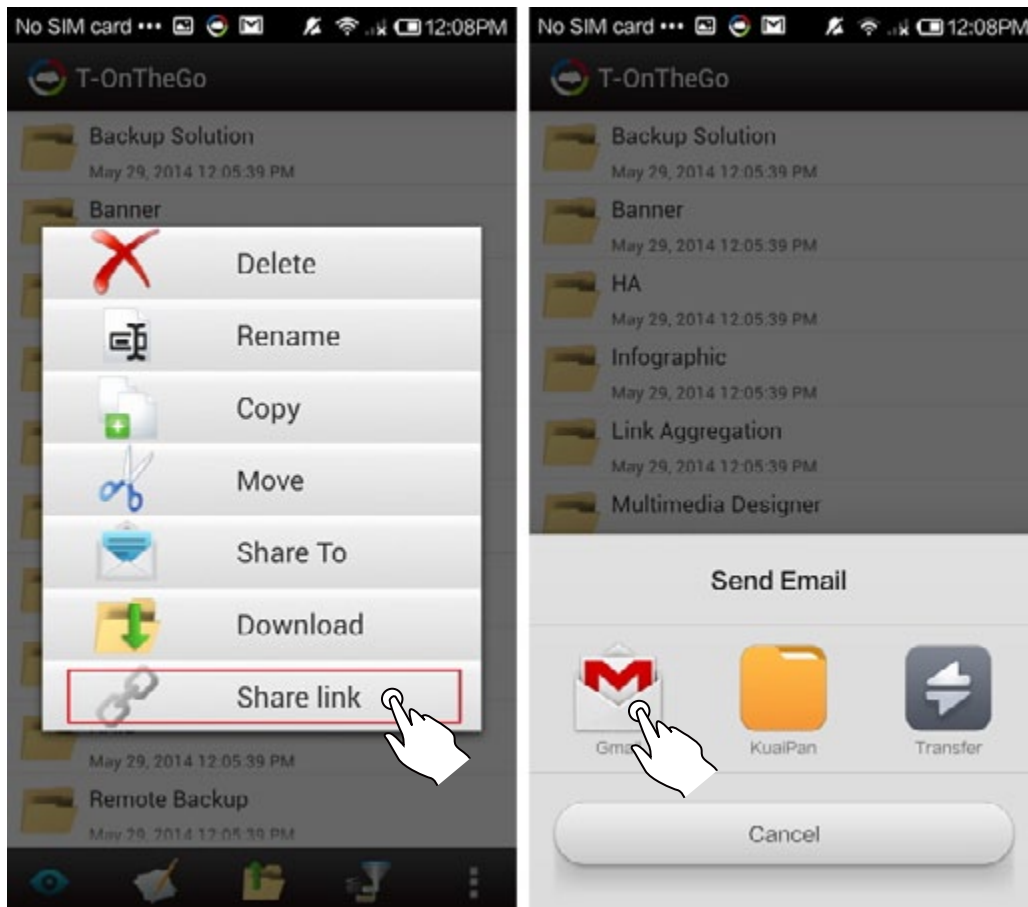
Step 3: Input the contact email you want to share, then send it. For security consideration, the link will expired after seven days.



❖ 3-Step to share your files (for Android)

Step 1: Long press the file/folder, and the menu will be displayed. Tap the "Share Link" item.

Step 2: Select the method you want to share, and it depends on the application on your mobile device. We select Gmail in the tutorial.



Step 3: Input the contact email you want to share, then send it. For security consideration, the link will expired after seven days.
