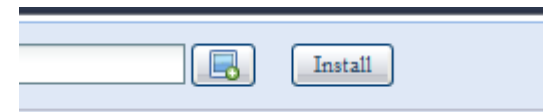
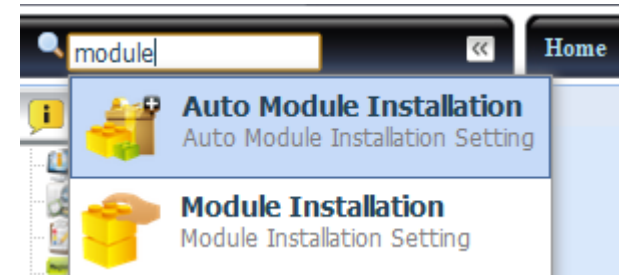
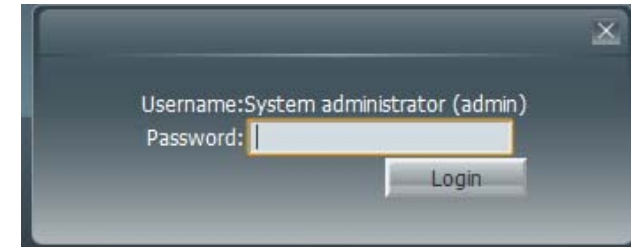

Requirements

- One compatible Thecus NAS connected to Internet
- One Dropbox account
- The Dropbox module
 - From Auto-Module Installation (skip to page 5)
 - From Thecus Website
- Difficulty: easy

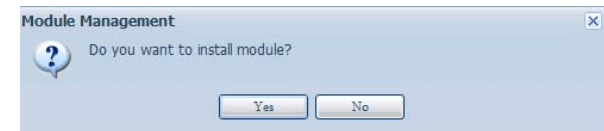
Manually Installing the Module

- Log into the UI
- Type “**module**” into the Search Bar
- Click on “**Module Installation**”
- Click on the browse button, select your module
- Click on “**Install**”

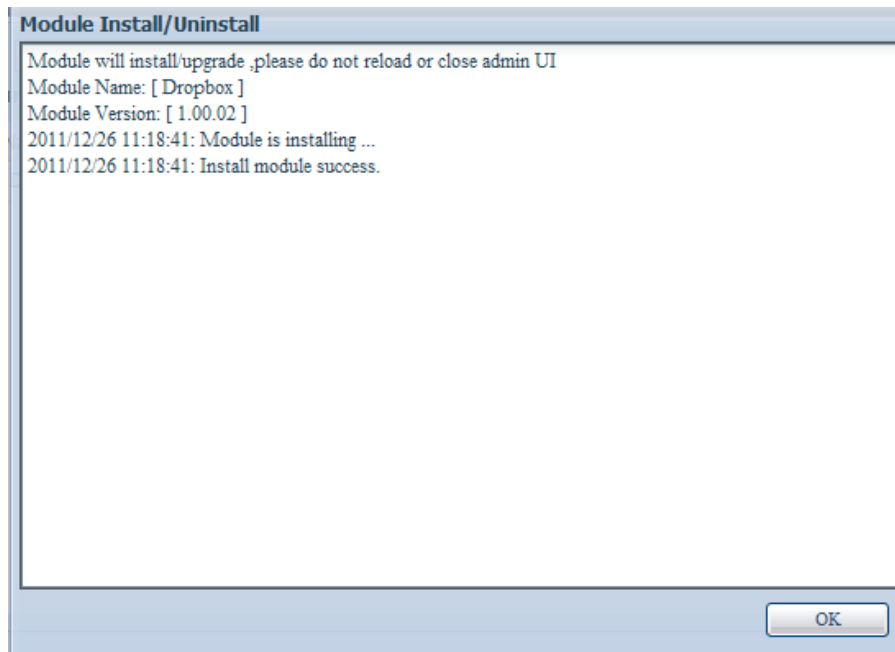


Manually Installing the Module

- Confirm the installation

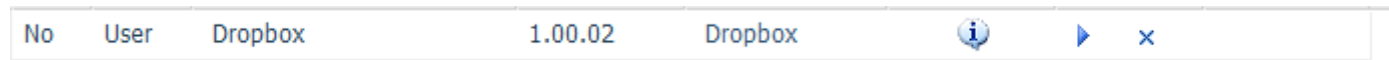


- Wait until the installation is complete then press **“OK”**



Starting the module

- Click on the play button



- Confirm by clicking “Yes”
- The module is now enabled



- If you already configured an user account **skip to page 8**

Creating an User

- Type “**Local User**” in the Search Bar



- Click on “**Local User Configuration**”
- Click on “**Add**” then enter parameters: login name/password. For this example: Test/test

Creating an User

- Click on “**Apply**”, your user is created!

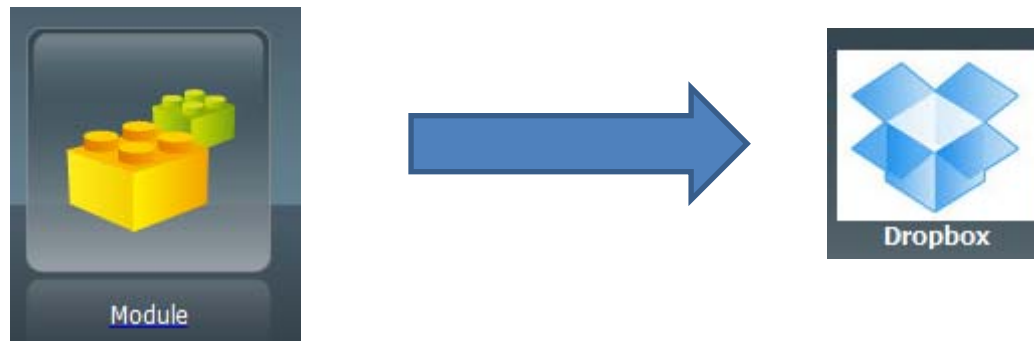


- **Logout** from the UI

Starting Dropbox Service

- On the welcome screen, click on “**Module**” then “**Dropbox**” (pop-up must be allowed)



- You can now **login using your user credentials** (pop-up must be allowed)



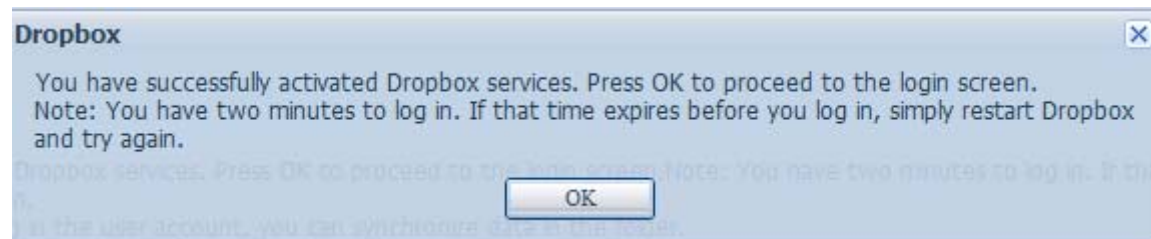



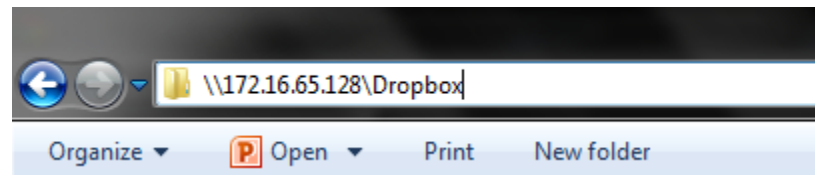
Accessing to the Sync Folder

- Congratulations! Your NAS is synchronized with your Dropbox account! You need now to access to your folder from your computer.
- Copy the Storage Path indicated by your NAS (`\\xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx\Dropbox`)

Accessing to the Sync Folder

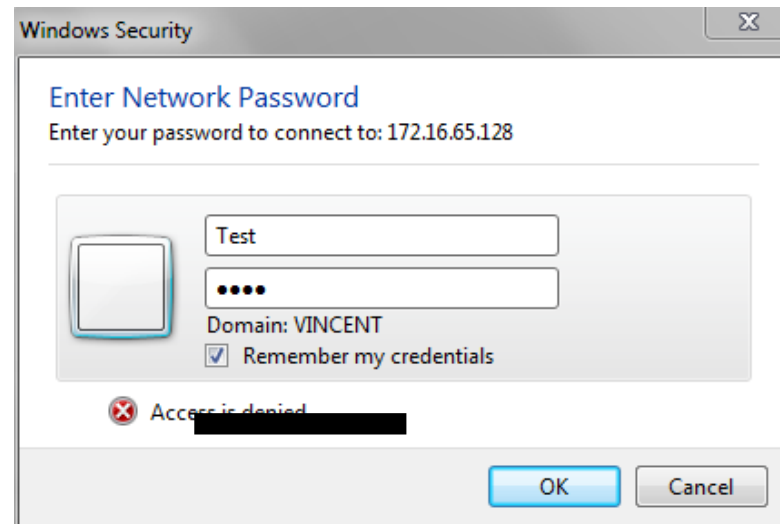
- **Paste into** your Explorer navigation bar (here on Windows 7)



- Then press **Enter**

Accessing to the Sync Folder

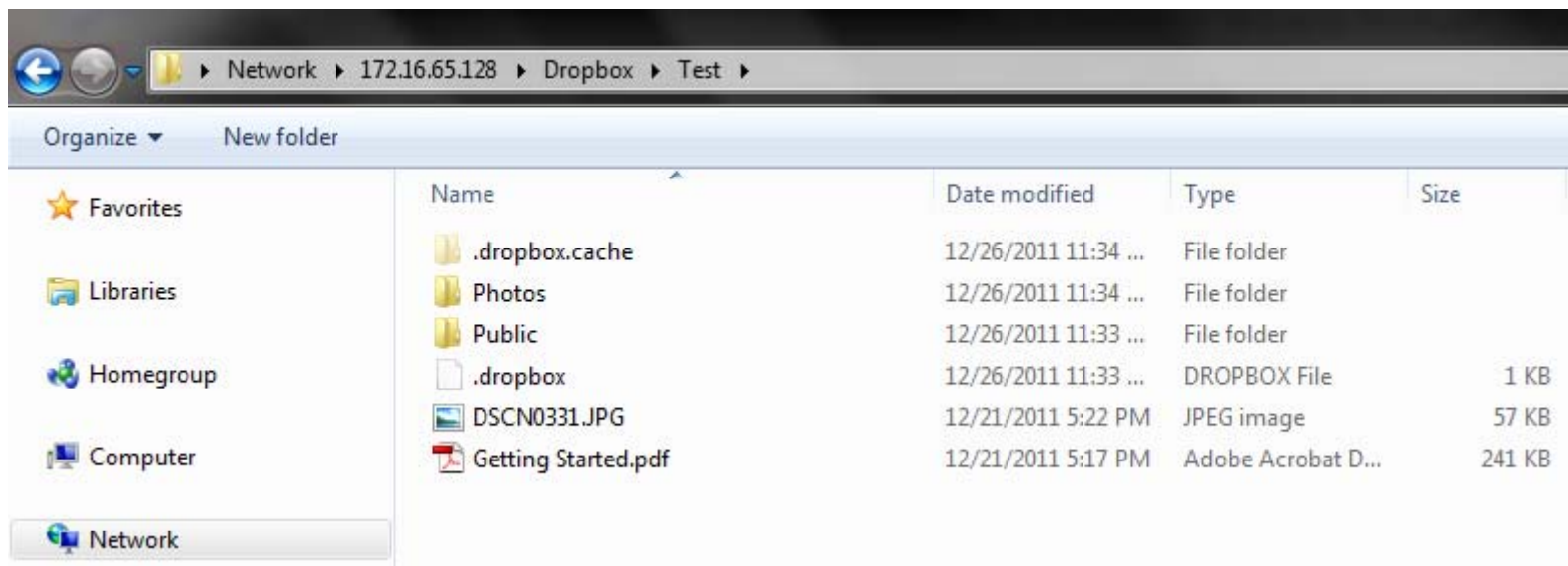
- Enter your **User credentials**. Check “Remember my credentials” if needed.
- Then **Confirm**



- That's all, congratulations!

The Sync Folder

- It will work exactly like a Dropbox folder. Everything you add/delete will be added/deleted on your Dropbox account



Tips

- Create a shortcut of your Dropbox folder for easier daily usage
- You can unlink your NAS from your Dropbox account parameters in “My computers”
- Always be sure to have enough space on your Dropbox account.
